BOOKINGS

All bookings are to be made online via the Adelaide Festival Centre website: www.adelaideguitarfestival.com.au

FEE SCHEDULE

\$250.00 per participant, per stream, for 5 days. (All transactions incur an \$8.95 Ticketek transaction fee, if booking for multiple participants we encourage you to book them all in a single transaction.)

Participants must attend for the full 5 days in their selected program stream. Individual day bookings are not permitted.

Blues & Roots: 10 - 14 July, 2023

Adelaide Guitar Festival Orchestra (AGFO): 10 - 14 July, 2023

Registrations close on **14 June 2023**

Bookings will require full payment at time of booking.

PAYMENT METHOD

Payment of the full fees can be made online by credit card on the Adelaide Guitar Festival website.

PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

- Full program fees remain payable if a participant is absent for one or more days of the AGFWS (*circumstance dependent*).
- Full program fees remain payable if a participant does not continue due to 'change of mind'.
- Limited centrED equity subsidies are available to primary and secondary students who otherwise may not be able to attend due to financial hardship or distance. Email centrED@adelaidefestivalcentre.com.au for more information on how your student can receive this support. Please note that funding is limited and will be approved on a case-by-case basis until exhausted.

BEHAVIOUR

The Adelaide Festival Centre does not tolerate harassment, bullying and/or discrimination. We require all participants, staff, tutors, artists and volunteers to:

- Participants are required to bring a bottle of water and their own food for morning tea/recess and lunch. Please do not send money for purchased items. Food products containing nuts are not permitted.
- Bringing electronic devices and expensive personal belongings is not recommended and is done at your own risk.
- Please wear clean and comfortable clothing that is conducive to playing guitar.

INJURY, FIRST AID & EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- Participants (aged 18 and older) or Parents/Guardians (of participants who are aged 17 or younger) consent to participation in the Adelaide Guitar Festival Winter School activities at their own risk and participate within their own limitations and capabilities.
- All Participants are expected to abide by any COVID response measures of government, including, but not limited to, checking in to the venue each day, hygiene protocols, the wearing of masks and any required social distancing.
- If you present with any symptoms or are ill you are required to stay home, present for a COVID test and alert the AGFWS of the results. This may result in your inability to continue with the course. Refunds will only be considered if a majority of the course is remaining.
- If an injury occurs, either prior to or during class, it is the responsibility of the participant or parent/guardian to notify staff of such injury.
- The Participant or Parent/Guardian agrees to accept full responsibility for any injury sustained by themselves or their child while attending classes, for an injury to themselves or their child in the waiting areas, and for any loss or damage of property.
- Due to the physical nature of guitar playing, some physical contact may be necessary by a class tutor to demonstrate exercises or techniques during class or if there is need to administer first aid.
- If a participant suffers any trauma through injury, accident or other circumstance, in line with AFC first aid procedures, an immediate risk assessment will be done assessing whether an ambulance will need to be called. If under the age of 18, attempts will be made to contact the parent, however, if the parent is unavailable on the contact numbers provided, we will then contact the emergency contact listed on the enrolment form.
- Any injuries or minor first aid that occurs will be communicated to the relevant Parent/Guardian after class on the same day by the class tutor or present staff member.

ARRIVALS, DEPARTURES, ABSENCE

- Parents/Guardians (of participants aged 17 or younger) are required to deliver, collect and sign in/out participants from a designated collection point specified in the information pack
- No participant aged 17 or younger will be released without sign-off by a parent /guardian unless the parent/guardian specifies on the registration form that the participant may leave unsupervised (children 15 years and over only).
- Absences must be notified to the AGFWS Staff by 9am on the day of absence via guitar.festival@adelaidefestivalcentre.com.au or 8216 8768
- Any permissions alternate to the above need to be arranged with the Adelaide Guitar Festival prior to the start date on the details above.
