



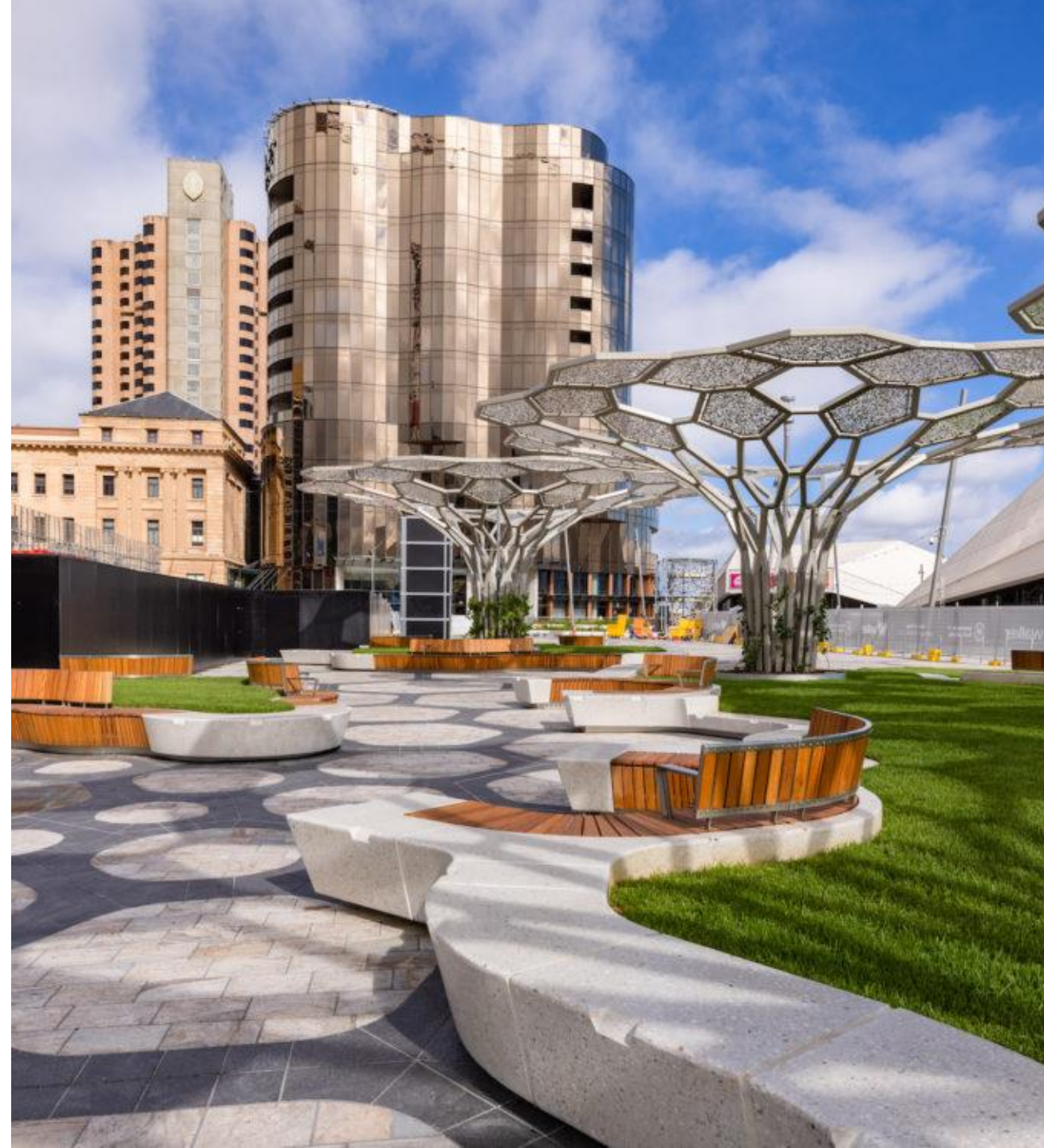
DreamBIG Birthday Parade Visual Story
