ABOUT THE ADELAIDE FESTIVAL CENTRE FOUNDATION

The Adelaide Festival Centre Foundation was incorporated in 1999 and was established to support the work of the Adelaide Festival Centre (AFC) specifically in improving and enhancing the physical facilities and environment of the Centre and to support the participation of underprivileged children in the Performing Arts. The Foundation undertakes special projects which advance the AFC's vision of being consistently recognised as a world class performing arts centre.

The Foundation's mission is to enrich the lives of generations to come and give young South Australians an experience that lasts a lifetime. We believe participating in the arts is an important part of growing up. It develops children's minds and spirits so that they can contribute more meaningfully to our community in the future.

Our main focus is to provide children experiencing disadvantage with the opportunity to attend live theatre. Research has found that children who are least likely to be able to access performing arts have the most to gain from experiencing them.

GOLF DAY OBJECTIVE

100% of the net proceeds raised at this annual AFC Foundation Charity Golf Day will go directly to our Foundation that principally funds the following children and youth programs:

1. **Equity Tix** ... the opportunity for children experiencing disadvantage to access live theatre for the first time ever
2. **OnStage Grants** ... established to support geographically and financially disadvantaged children to participate in this popular school holiday program for children interested in learning any form of the performing arts
3. **Something on Saturday** (Foundation Kids Corner Workshops) ... designed for children aged 2 - 12 years, providing free and engaging theatre and performing arts workshops throughout the year
4. **Green Room Youth Membership program** ... offering 18-30-year olds with exclusive "backstage" experiences as well as mentoring, coaching and work experience
5. **International Guitar Competition** ... providing young aspiring guitarists from all over the world the opportunity to be heard and given exposure on an international platform at the annual Adelaide Guitar Festival
6. **Steel Ryan Fellowship** ... a 12-month fellowship with preference for an Indigenous person to be mentored, coached and professionally trained and developed for a career in the performing arts
7. **International Fellowships** ... to provide young Chinese arts administrators the opportunity to spend 10 months working with professional arts workers at the AFC
